and assigns forever.

Item, I give unto my said sister all my money debts or wages which shall be due to me from any
person or persons at my decease.

Item, I give all my wearing apparel unto the male children of John Howland Junr. to be divided
among them as he shall think fit, and I nominate and appoint John Howland of Bristol Esq. to be
Executor of this my last will ratifying this and this & none other to be my last will and testament.
