

I, Joseph Munroe of Bristol, in the County of Bristol, and State of Rhode Island &c. being weak and infirm in body, but of a sound and disposing mind, memory, and understanding, do make this my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say-

First- I order and direct my Executor, herein after Named, to pay all my just debts, and funeral expenses, as soon as may be, after My decease.

Second- I give and devise to my daughter Abby Bunn, the wife of Lemuel Bunn, and to her heirs and assigns forever, all of My orchard lot so called, That has not before been conveyed to Lemuel Bunn Junior, which said orchard lot or so Much Thereof as is hereby devised, is bounded Easterly and Northerly by land of Lemuel Bunn Junior, Westerly by my Barn lot so called and hereinafter devised to My son Nathan Munroe, and Southerly by land of Elijah Grey, or however the same may be bounded.

Third. - I give and devise to my son Nathan Munro, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the lot of land next adjoining and west of said orchard lot, known as my Barn lot, bounded Easterly by said orchard lot, Southerly by land of Elijah Grey, Westerly by land herein after devised by me to my daughter Abby Bunn and my grand-son Lemuel Bunn Junior, And Northerly by a drift-way leading from the Back road so called to Kickameuit River, with a right of Egress from and ingress to said lot, in and Through said driftway.

Fourth- I give and devise to my said daughter Abby Bunn, and my grand-son Lemuel Bunn Junior as tenants in common, and not as joint tenants, and to Their heirs and assigns forever, the lot of land next adjoining and west of my said Barn lot, bounded Easterly by said Barn lot, Southerly by land of Elijah Grey, Westerly in part by a lot of land belonging to George Munroe the second, and in part by a lot of land herein after devised by Me to my daughter Christiana Handy, and Northerly by said driftway before named, or however the same may be bounded; with the right of ingress to and egress from said lot hereby devised, in and Through said driftway.

Fifth- I give and devise to my daughter Christiana Handy, and her heirs and assigns forever, a lot of land next west of and adjoining the lot of land herein before devised to my daughter Abby Bunn, and my grand-son Lemuel Bunn Junior, and bounded Easterly by said lot last named, as devised to said Abbey and Lemuel, Southerly by land of George Munroe 2nd, Westerly by a lot of land herein after devised by me to my sons Caleb, David, Bosworth K, and Joseph Munroe, and my daughter Sally Munro, and Northerly by said drift way before named; or however said lot hereby devised may be bounded, with a right of ingress to, and egress from said lot, in and Through said driftway.

Sixth- I give and devise to my daughter in law Nancy Munroe, and to her heirs and assigns forever, one half of an acre of land at the West end of My farm, and which said half acre of land hereby devised, is bounded Westerly by land of Joseph Munro the Third, Southerly by land of George Munro the second, Northerly by said driftway before named, and is to extend far enough

East of equal width to embrace one half part of one acre, together with a right of ingress to, and egress from said lot hereby devised in and through said driftway.

Seventh- I give and devise to my four sons, Caleb Munroe, David Munro, Bosworth K. munro, and Joseph Munro Junior, and to my daughter Sally Munro, and to their heirs and assigns forever, share and share alike, all the rest and residue of my real estate.

Eighth- After the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses, I give and bequeath to My said daughter Abby Bunn, and to her executors, administrators and assigns, all of my personal property, of every name and nature.

Lastly- I hereby appoint Nathan M. Bunn sole executor of This My last will and testament; hereby revoking and annulling all other and former wills by me made, and establishing this and this only as my last will and testament,
