I Newby Coggeshall, of Bristol, in the County of Bristol, in the State of Rhode Island &c. Esqr., now enjoying in my advanced Age a comfortable state of health, and a sound disposing mind and memory, for which singular favour, I acknowledge the divine Goodness; Now calling to mind that its appointed for all Men to die, do therefore set my house in order, by putting and leaving this my last Will and Testament in writing in the following manner, /to wit/ Principally and first of all I commend my Soul into the hands of its Creator, and my Body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, in hopes of a part in the first Resurrection, and touching my Estate God hath blest me with I dispose in the following manner. –

Imprimus. I give and Bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Coggeshall, the use and improvement of the One half part of my Dwelling-house where I now dwell, and the North-west Garden as it is now enclosed and fenced in and five Cords of fire-wood, and fifty silver Dollars, to be paid to her yearly and every year by my four Sons, namely William, James, Henry, and John Coggeshalls, during the term she "she" shall remain my widow, share and share alike, and also my Negro Woman Pegge, the one half part of all my household furniture, one good horse, and Cow, which my four sd. Sons shall make provision for Summer and Winter, during her widowhood, all which said articles and gifts are to be considered as her Right of Dower in and unto all my Real Estate.

Item. I Give and Bequeath, to my beloved Son William Coggeshall, and to his heirs and assigns forever, A certain tract or parcel of Land, situate on the East side of said Bristol-neck, it being part of my farm lying at the Narrows /so called/ bounded /to wit/ beginning at the North-west corner thereof, from thence running Southerly on the dividing line between said farm and land partly Thomas Gray's and partly Hezekiah Munro's One hundred and thirty six Rods, then turning and running Easterly on a parallel line with the North line of said Farm Eighty two Rods, then turning running Northerly Eighteen Rods, then turning Easterly, on a direct line parallel with said North line, by a stone wall, at the Salt water or Mount Bay /so called/ thence Northerly by said Bay to said North line, then turning and running Wasterly by said North line to the to the said first mentioned bound. –

Item. I Give and Bequeath to my beloved Son James Coggeshall, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the remainder, or South part of my said farm at the Narrows, bounded, /to wit/ Westerly on land of Hezekiah Munro, Southerly on land of George Coggeshall, Easterly on said Mount Bay, and Northerly, by that line of the bounds before described in the land given to his brother William Coggeshall. –

Item. I Give and Bequeath to my two beloved Sons, namely- Henry Coggeshall and John Coggeshall, and to their heirs and assigns forever, all my homestead farm where I now dwell with all the buildings thereon standing, situate on the Main Road, leading from Bristol-town, to the Town of Warren, and likewise about two acres of Salt Marsh meadow, with the Beach thereto joining, which I bought of Samuel Throope deceased, both which said described peices of Land with the buildings thereon, are to be equally divided between my two said Sons Henry Coggeshall and John Coggeshall, and their heirs & assigns share and share alike. –

Item. I Give and Bequeath, to my two beloved Daughters, namely Haile Coomer, the wife of John Coomer Junr. and Mary Coomer the wife of Thomas K. Coomer, the other remaining half part of my household furniture /not before given to their mother) to be equally divided between them, in quantity and quality, share and share alike; I also give to my two said Daughters Six-hundred silver Dollars, to be equally divided between them share and share alike, to be paid to them in the following manner, by my Executors herein named /to wit) One-hundred Dollars, yearly to my Daughter Haile Coomer, and One hundred dollars to Mary Coomer, yearly the payments to begin at my decease. –

And of this my last Will and Testament I do make, ordain, constitute and appoint, my four said Sons- William Coggeshall, James Coggeshall, Henry Coggeshall and John Coggeshall, to be my Executors, revoking, disannulling and making Void all other and former Wills and Testaments Devises, and Bequests, by me heretofore made, hereby Ratifying and confirming this and only this to be my last Will and Testament. – In Testimony thereof I the said Newby Coggeshall hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty sixth Day of March One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Nine. –

I Newby Coggeshall, aforenamed, do this Second day of April, A.D. 1805, make and publish this Codicil to my foregoing last Will and Testament, which in all respects / excepting so far as the same is hereby altered or revoked) I hereby confirm. Whereas I have made & executed unto my aforesd. son James Coggeshall, a Deed of the land which in my aforegoing Will is devised to him, and whereas my said son James, intends soon to move into the Western part of the State of New York, and it will be inconvenient to him to Execute the trust of one of the Executors of my said Will, I do therefore hereby declare & make known, that the said Devise, to my said Son James, shall cease & be of no effect & I do release and discharge my said Son from the duty & Office of an Executor of my said Will. it is further my Will, that the Legacy given in my said Will, to my Daughter Haile Coomer / who has deceased since my said Will was made/ shall go & the same is hereby Bequeathed to my said deceased daughters Children, share and share alike, to be paid in like manner as is directed for the payment what was given to their Mother; and it is my Will, that the said Estate devised to my Sons William, Henry, and John, shall be holden in

their hands respectively liable for their respective proportions of said pecuniary Legacies; furthermore I direct that my said three Sons, shall pay my Just debts, and I give to them Equally all the residue of my personal Estate after payment of debts & Legacies. – In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & year above written. –
